## How to join the Islington NQT register

There is an online application process for all prospective applicants for posts in primary, secondary, nursery, special schools and Early Years/Children's Centres.

The online application is available at: [www.nqtatislington.co.uk](http://www.nqtatislington.co.uk).

Applicant's details will be provided to schools via a database which schools can access at any time. Headteachers will choose to contact candidates, invite them for an interview and discuss available post/s. Some schools will also advertise independently, usually in the Times Educational Supplement, and for these posts applicants should apply directly to schools to receive job details.
